

Glen Eira Libraries BIG Summer Read Summer Reading Challenge TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2021-22

1. ELIGIBILITY AND HOW TO PLAY

- a) The Big Summer Read Competition is run by Public Libraries Victoria ('PLV') and is supported by Glen Eira City Council ('Council')
- b) Participants can download the Beanstack Tracker App through the App Store or Google Play or register to play at <u>https://plv.beanstack.org</u>
- c) Paper forms will also be available from 1 December 2021 at any Glen Eira Library branch
- d) Participants (both online and with the paper form) must read a minimum of 10 (ten) books and complete 5 (five) of the activity challenges listed in the BIG Summer Read challenge on Beanstack, or listed on the paper entry form, and log them in Beanstack to be eligible for a prize.
- e) Paper entries returned to the Library will be manually entered on Beanstack as Offline readers by library staff. Entrants who complete the paper entry form will then be treated the same as Online readers and go into the same prize draw.
- **f)** Reading and logging additional books and completing more challenges will increase the chances of winning a prize.
- g) The competition is open to Glen Eira library members aged 0-18 years
- **h)** Employees of Glen Eira City Council and their children **may** enter the competition. However, they are not eligible for prizes.
- i) Entrants must be registered through the PLV Beanstack account and must choose Glen Eira Libraries as their Library Service to be eligible to win.
- j) Entrants must live in Victoria

- **k)** Entrants must have their parent or legal guardian's consent to enter the competition
- I) Limit of one entry per person.
- **m)** Council may, acting in its entire discretion, amend these conditions at any time without prior notice.
- n) Entrants acknowledge and agree that the competition, including the prize draw, will be administered by PLV in accordance with their <u>terms and</u> <u>conditions.</u>
- By entering the competition, you give permission for your child's first name to be displayed at Glen Eira Libraries branches, on Instagram or Facebook, library website and eNewsletter.

2. IMPORTANT DATES AND DEADLINES

- a) Competition opens: Wednesday 1 December 2021 at 9am (AESDT)
- b) Competition closes: Monday 31 January at 5pm (AESDT)
- c) Entries need to be submitted by 5pm on 31 January 2022. No late entries will be accepted. This includes the return of paper forms.
- d) Prize draw will be conducted by PLV. This will be a random draw and will take place on Friday 4 February 2022

3. PRIZES AND SELECTION

- a) Entrants who read at least 10 books and complete at least 5 of the activity challenges will be entered into the draw to win one of the following prizes:
 - First prize: \$250 Book Voucher
 - Second Prize: \$150 Book Voucher
 - Third prize: \$100 Book Voucher
- **b)** Prizes cannot be exchanged for cash, transferred or otherwise exchanged.
- c) Prize draw will be conducted by PLV. Winners will be notified by phone and email by Friday 18 February 2022
- d) Winners must be able to collect their prize from a Glen Eira Libraries branch. Council accepts no responsibility for lost prizes.
- e) Prize outcomes are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Beanstack's (Zoobean) servers are US-based, and to safeguard users' privacy they ask for the bare minimum of personal information: email, name (an alias is acceptable), age and library service.
