

## **Glen Eira Libraries Book Bingo - Conditions of Entry**

Book Bingo ('Competition') is run by Glen Eira City Council ('Council').

1. By entering the Competition, entrants accept these terms and conditions of entry ('Conditions').
2. **For eligibility to enter the Competition:**
  - a. Councillors, officers, and employees of Council and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter. Immediate family includes a spouse or former spouse, de facto partner or former de facto partner, child, parent, grandparent, grandchild or sibling of an employee, or a child, parent, grandparent, grandchild or sibling of an employee's spouse or de facto partner. It includes step-relations (eg. step-parents and step-children) as well as adoptive relations.
  - b. The entrant must submit a valid entry to be determined by Council in its absolute discretion.
  - c. The Competition is open to children aged 5-18
  - d. Entrants under the ages of 18, or their parent/guardian, need to be a member of Glen Eira Libraries to be eligible to go into the draw for the book voucher.
3. **To enter the Competition:**
  - a. The entrant must submit their completed Bingo Card in the marked box by 5pm AEST on Sunday 25 August 2024.
  - b. The entry must be submitted between 10am AEST Saturday 17 August , and Sunday 25 August 5pm AEST. Entries outside of these times will not be accepted unless Council extends the competition period, in which case notice will be provided on the website <http://library.gleneira.vic.gov.au>
  - c. Entrants must not submit more than one entry.
4. There will be one (1) winner selected at random. The winner will be the first valid entry drawn from all entries received by Council.
5. The draw will take place at Glen Eira Town Hall oat 11am AEST on Tuesday 27 August
6. If there is a dispute as to the identity of a winner, Council reserves the right to determine the winner in its absolute discretion.
7. The prize is not transferable, exchangeable, or redeemable for cash.
8. All entrants consent and agree to the Council displaying, publishing the winner's first name on our website, on social media, or in print media.

9. The winner will be notified in writing via email at their nominated address.
10. If a prize is not accepted or claimed within 28 days of the notification to the winner, the prize will be deemed unclaimed. It will then be at Council's discretion whether to disregard the winner and choose a new winner to award the unclaimed prize.
11. Council is not liable for late, lost, incomplete, invalid or incorrectly submitted entries, or illegible, corrupted or misdirected entries, claims or correspondence due to error, omission, alteration, tampering, deletion, theft, destruction, transmission interruption and communications failure or otherwise.
12. Council is not liable for any loss (including but not limited to any damage, claim, injury, cost or expense) which is suffered or incurred by any person in connection with or arising from redemption or use of a prize.
13. Privacy  
The personal information requested is required primarily to enable you to participate in the Competition, and subject to Clause 8, will only be shared with those directly responsible for providing that service. If you do not provide the information, we may not be able to consider your competition entry.
